Dear Representative Kyl:

I am writing to you about the June 1990 decision by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to reclassify low-level radioactive materials as "Below Regulatory Concern". This policy allows two things:

1. Low-level radioactive waste to be used in consumer and industrial products, dumped into landfills, and poured down the drain
2. May prevent complete clean-ups of retired and contaminated nuclear power and weapons plants

I urge you to support or propose legislation to overturn the new policy by the NRC.
