SUBJECT: SAFETY EVALUATION FOR THE RESOLUTION OF PIPING ANALYSES NONCONFORMING CONDITIONS - NINE MILE POINT NUCLEAR STATION, UNIT NO. 2 (TAC NO. 77264)

On June 22, 1990, Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation (NMPC) reported to the NRC per 10 CFR 50.72 that a review of the safety related pipe stress calculations for the Standby Liquid Control System at Nine Mile Point 2 revealed potential nonconforming conditions. The nonconforming conditions included errors in the modeling and analysis of the piping systems and the failure to perform the analyses of piping systems in accordance with criteria specified in the Updated Safety Analysis Report (USAR). These nonconforming conditions potentially affected the Standby Liquid Control System, the Reactor Water Cleanup System, the Main Steam System, and the Primary Containment Penetrations.

By letter dated June 29, 1990, NMPC provided a preliminary evaluation of the nonconforming conditions with regard to continued safe operation. By letter dated July 27, 1990, and supplemented November 30, 1990, NMPC provided further information regarding a closure plan and corrective actions for this issue. NMPC proposed to reanalyze the affected systems using criteria specified in the USAR with two exceptions. The first exception involves NMPC's proposal to use the ASME Code Class 1 piping fatigue exemption rules in the Summer 1976 Addenda. The second exception involves NMPC's proposed corrections to the USAR containment penetrations load combination table.

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The staff has reviewed NMPC's proposed correction actions for the nonconforming conditions and concluded that they are acceptable. The enclosed safety evaluation documents the staff's approval. All staff activities related to TAC No. 77264 are considered complete.
