This acknowledges the receipt of Mr. D. B. Karner's letter dated February 6, 1989 (161-01671-DJK/BJA), by which you transmitted Amendments 18 (Revision 1) and 21 to the Palo Verde Nuclear Generating Station (PVNGS) Security Plan, dated October 1979. Revision 21 was subsequently modified by W. F. Conway's letters dated April 3, 1990, and December 18, 1990 (161-03029-WFC/GEC and 161-03660-WFC/GEC, respectively), transmitting Amendments 25 and 27, respectively, to the PVNGS Security Plan. Amendment 18, including Revision 1, was accepted by letter from M. Lamastra to D. Karner, dated May 10, 1989.


This letter concerns only Amendment 21, as clarified by modified page 9-1 (submitted as part of Amendment 25) and modified page 11-4 (submitted as part of Amendment 27). Amendments numbered greater than 21 have not yet been reviewed and will be addressed in separate reviews and correspondence.

We find the changes identified in Amendment 21, modified as noted above, to be consistent with the provisions of 10 CFR Part 50.54(p). Accordingly, they are acceptable for inclusion in the plan.

The attachments to the referenced letters are being withheld from public disclosure because they contain Safeguards Information and must be protected in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR Part 73.21.
