I wish to inform you that Mr. Lynch has been named as Project Manager for the resolution of NRC efforts regarding the static eliminator program. We understand that you will-provide us with a list of all static eliminators which were not returned in response to the February 18, 1988 Order by April 26, 1989 and that all future Order responses, will also include this information. This list will include those devices that are classified as "lost". Additionally, we understand that a comprehensive listing of 3M customer site surveys will be submitted to this office by May 5, 1989. As Mr. Lynch informed you, we encourage 3M to make every effort to retrieve static eliminators from customer facilities even though the NRC may be in the process of sending Notices of Violation to those individuals. A letter will be issued to 3M in May 1989 which should answer questions raised in your March 31, 1989 letter. If matters remain unresolved after your receipt of our letter, we may schedule a meeting to discuss those issues.
