Subject: PERSONNEL INJURY

On December 15, 1982, at 2047 hours, two Nuclear Electronic Technicians, employees of the licensee, suffered third degree burns from electrical shock while working on 6900V Bus-work in the Reactor Coolant Pump Breaker Panel.

The incident occured when one employee came in contact with the Bus causing several arcs and catching both individuals on fire. Nearby workers put the fire out with Co<sub>2</sub> Fire exting-

uishers. Both were transfered to Peekskill hospital. One individual was subsequently transfered to Westchester County Medical Center Burn Unit.

As of 0600 a.m. December 16, 1982 one individual is reported stable with third degree burns over 25% of his body. The other individual is in critical condition with third degree burns over 60-90% of his body.

At 2100 hours the licensee notified the NRC via the ENS and made emergency notification in accordance with their Emergency Plan for information only. The licensee issued a press release at midnight December 15, 1982.

The plant is currently shutdown for a refueling outage and steam generator repairs. No contamination or radiation was involved.

The NRC does not plan to issue a press release but will respond to inquiries. The State of New York has been notified. OSHA will be notified in accordance with NRC procedure.
