This letter is in response to a telephone conversation between D. G. Raasch (District) and John F. Stolz (NRC) on November 22, 1982, and provides clarification as requested.

The District's response to Generic Letter 81-10 includes the following letters:

The District is making no provisions for a backup EOF. The General Office Annex located at 1826 - 61st Street is 23 miles from the Rancho Seco site, and no backup is recommended. The protection factor concept is not relevant at this distance.
