Dr. Okrest has asked that I reply to your imquiry of December 5, 1966.

The phrase "without undue risk to the public health and safety" is used in 10 CFR Fart 50 of the Atomic Energy Commission's regulations. The Commission has not prepared a written interpretation of this phrase. However, comments concerning the meaning of the phrase "without undue risk to the health and safety of the public" were requested of the AEC's Regulatory Staff by the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board in the matter of the Department of Water & Power of the City of Los Angeles, Docket Mo. 50-214. The reply of the Regulatory Staff was filed in February 1966. A capy is enclosed for your information.
