Dear Mr. Stoiber:

Enclosed please find a letter from G. A. Technologies, Incorporated requesting an amendment to export license XSNM01360 to increase the quantity of uranium-235, and thorium-232 presently authorized for export and to add 21 grams of uranium-233 and 0.9 gram of plutonium.

Through an oversight, the request was forwarded only to the Department of Energy, on November 22, 1982, for their assistance in obtaining the necessary assurance letter. However, since the request is for greater than 10 grams of uranium-233, full Executive Branch review is needed.

We would appreciate your views, in accordance with established procedures and from the overall perspective of the Executive Branch, as to whether the proposed export meets the applicable criteria in the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 as amended by the Nuclear Nonproliferation Act of 1978. Your early response would be greatly appreciated.

Copies of all previous correspondence, the original license, and all amendments to this license are attached for your use in reviewing this request.
