Dear Mr. Gillen:

Effective January 1, 1983, the radiation protection and monitoring requirements of Federal-American Partners will be assigned to Mr. Jerry W. Lucas. Mr. Lucas will replace Mr. Joseph R. Lane as Radiation Safety Officer for the FAP operation and will be responsible to see that the requirements of the License and it's Amendments and Conditions are met.

Mr. Lucas joined the staff of FAP in July of 1978. He has worked with and substituted for Mr. Lane in the areas of occupational and environmental radiation monitoring. Mr. Lucas' first experience in the field of radiation safety came from 4 years with the U. S. Navy as a hospital Corpsman. His training and duties included, X-rays and radiation treatment, plus de-contamination and monitoring. After the Navy, Jerry received an Associate of Applied Science Degree in 1973, from Laramie County Community College, Cheyenne, Wyoming, and was certified as an X-ray technologist. Subsequently he has been certified as a Registered Technologist in X-Ray Technology by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists since 1974.

While on staff at FAP he has received further radiation training by attending an Oil Field Radiation Safety School. The school consisted of about 75% radiation health physics and radiation safety. He just recently completed a very extensive course in Oklahoma City, on radiation safety offered through Oklahoma State University.



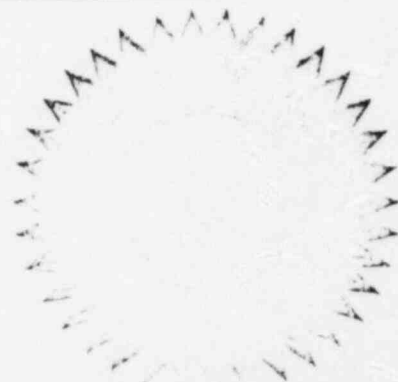
