You submitted a letter dated December 7, 1982, in which you provided, as an attachment to your letter, a discussion of the scope of your design verification program. Your attachment reflects the material discussed in our meeting on December 1, 1982, at which we approved your proposed program, subject to our review of the detailed proposal submitted to you by Cygna Energy Services. This document was subsequently submitted as an enclosure to your letter dated December 14, 1982.

Based on our review of the additional information you submitted and having previously approved the proposed scope of work, we find that your proposal is acceptable. Considering the results of previous Quality Assurance evaluations and special checks on your design (e.g., the core spray system), we believe that this verification program provides a substantive commitment by Detroit Edison to ensure a quality of design necessary to meet all the requirements of the Fermi 2 FSAR. 
