SUBJECT:

STATUS OF LER RULEMAKING

By memo dated December 1, 1982, Samuel Chilk informed the staff of the Commission's decision to proceed with the LER rulemaking and requested that the staff inform the Commission regarding the status and schedule of the proposed final LER rule.

The original schedule for development of a final LER rule called for submission of the rule to the Commission by December 31, 1982. However, because of the potential impact that the Brookhaven Mational Laboratory report on LER system alternatives might have on the LER rule, the staff decided that the final LER rule should not be finalized and reviewed (e.g., by CRGR and ACRS) until there was an opportunity to review the conclusions and recommendations of the Brookhaven report and to incorporate any additional Commission guidance regarding the scope and content of the LER system. This decision to delay finalization of the LER rule was discussed with OPE and members of the Commissioners' staffs.

It should also be noted that the LER rulemaking has been integrated with 0/m-6-1 +1.+1,Pt.50 the 50.72 (Immediate Notification Requirement for Operating Nuclear Reactors) rulemaking. Therefore, both rules will be finalized, reviewed,

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and forwarded to the Commission as a single integrated program for the reporting of operational experience. This program consisting of the proposed final 50.72 and 50.73 rules will be forwarded to the Commission by April 29, 1983 (see attachment for the detailed milestones).

It should be noted, however, that the development of the LER rule is based in part on the assumption that the Nuclear Plant Reliability Data System (NPRDS) will achieve a sufficient level of effectiveness to provide some of the staff's essential needs for operational data. The current status of the NPROS is presently being evaluated by the staff. A judgment will be made whether the continuing poor utility participation in NPRDS should affect the schedule for proceeding with the LER rule.
