Subject: Meeting Summary

This letter refers to the meeting conducted at our request in the NRC Region II office on December 2, 1982. This meeting related to a security violation that occurred at Grand Gulf Unit 1. In addition MP&L requested this opportunity to discuss schedules for resolving outstanding items required for a full power license. The subjects discussed at this meeting are described in the enclosed meeting summary, Enclosure 1. A list of attendees at the meeting is contained in Enclosure 2.

It is our opinion that this meeting was beneficial and has provided for a better understanding of the corrective actions being taken and the inspection and enforcement issues. SUBJECT: MINUTES OF LICENSEE - NRC MEETING DECEMBER 2, 1982

On December 2, 1982, members of Mississippi Power & Light Company Senior Management met with the NRC to discuss selected issues. Those attending the meeting are listed in enclosure 2.

R. C. Lewis, Director, PRP stated the reason for the meeting and a NRC representative then stated the security violations as found by NRC inspectors. MP&L presented their corrective actions for each of the three findings. In addition MP&L presented their actions to alleviate the numerous security computer problems they have experienced.

NRC and MP&L discussed the interpretation of the Technical Specifications regarding violation 416/82-53-01, Discharge Basin Sampling, and MP&L's denial of the violation. The NRC is to discuss this further and contact MP&L to relate the NRC position.

MP&L discussed their method for ensuring that commitments are accomplished in a timely manner. MP&L presented their current and revised methods for tracking commitments. The revised method should ensure commitments are fully met. In addition MP&L committed to review the problems experienced with the control of temporary alterations.

MP&L discussed their schedules for resolving outstanding items for full power licensing, staffing plans, and the surveillance review program. Their expected date for the next criticality is March 15, 1983.
