The reports (referenced above) covering this project have been reviewed previously by the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards.

At the 22nd Meeting of the ACRS on July 15, 1957, a summary review and discussion was held with representatives of the General Electric Company and members of the AEC staff.

Based upon the information submitted and reviewed, the opinion of the ACRS is that the operation of the Developmental Boiling Water Reactor by the General Electric Company at the Vallecitos, California, site as proposed, can be conducted with reasonable assurance the health and safety of the public will not be endangered.
