However, condition 15 of the teletherapy license specifically excempts Grant Medical Center from the decommissioning financial assurance requirements for possession of licensed material in sealed sources in quantities greater than the limit in 10 CFR 30.35 for the purpose of source change.

If there is any ambiguity in the wording of the license, we suggest that it should be changed to clearly state that the maximum possession limit is 6000 curies in one source except that it is 12,000 curies in two scurces at the time of source change when condition 15 is applicable.

This is in response to your letter dated November 02, 1990, stating that Grant Medical Center may be in violation of 10 CFR 30.35, since we have not submitted a decommissioning funding plan or a certificate that financial assurance for decommissioning has been provided.

Grant Medical Center possesses and operates only one Cobalt-60 teletherapy machine containing only one source maximum presession limit for which is 6000 curies (see license # 34-0342.-03 copy attached), which is less than 10,000 curies, the activity above which a decommissioning funding plan or a certificate of nancial assurance for decommissioning is required by 10 CFR 30.35. Only time Grant Medical Center will exceed this possession limit will be at the time of source change. However, condition 15 of the teletherapy license specifically excempts Grant Medical Center from the decommissioning financial assurance requirements for possession of licensed material in sealed sources in quantities greater than the limit in 10 CFR 30.35 for the purpose of source change.

If there is any ambiguity in the wording of the license, we suggest that it should be changed to clearly state that the maximum possession limit is 6000 curies in one source except that it is 12.000 curies in two sources at the time of source change when condition 18 is applicable.
