## Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. J. L. During this inspection, certain of your activities under License No. 21-04127-02 appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Appendix and a written response is required. No violations were identified for Licenses No. 21-04127-06 and No. 21-04127-07.
