Gentlemen:

In response to your letter dated November 2, 1990, I am enclosing a copy of our license (amendment no. 8). Conditions 17 and 18 of the amendment indicate that Lester E. Cox Medical Center is exempted from decommissioning financial assurance requirements for possession of licensed material in sealed sources in quantities greater than the limits of 10 CFR 30.35(d) for the purpose of source changes only (maximum 30 days). Lester E. Cox Medical Center is authorized to possess 6700 curies of CD-60, which is less than the limits of 10 CFR 30.35(d). Therefore, Lester E. Cox Medical Center is not in violation of 10 CFR 30.35.

Conditions 17, and 18, are added:

- 17. The licensee is exempted from decommissioning financial assurance requirements for possession of licensed material in sealed sources in quantities greater than the limits of 10 CFR 30.35(d) for the purpose of source changes only. This exemption is granted for no more than 30 days for any one source change.
- The licensee shall maintain records of information important to safe and effective decommissioning at the address specified in Condition 10. per the provisions of 10 CFR 30.35(g) until this license is terminated by the Commission.
