SUBJECT: WELL SITE INSPECTION, INC. (01 CASE NO. 4-93-25R)

This letter refers to the NRC ORDER REVOKING LICENSE, dated October 23, 1992, and to the special, unannounced inspection by Mr. Robert A. Brown of this office on May 5, 1993. The purpose of the inspection was to ensure that the pipe wall thickness gauge, which had been authorized by the revoked license, had been disposed of properly upon receipt of the revocation order.

The referenced inspection and a subsequent investigation conducted by the NRC's Office of Investigations (OI) concluded that:

- On April 4, 1992, the State of Oklahoma suspended the corporate charter and, therefore, the right of the corporation to do buinsess in Oklahoma of Well Site Inspection, Inc. The corporation now defunct had been previously authorized by NRC License 35-23183-01 to possess a pipe wall thickness gauge.
- On May 5, 1993, an unlicensed entity called Well Site (nominally Mr. Justin McCollough) possessed the pipe wall thickness gauge formerly possessed by Well Site Inspection, Inc. under License 35-23183-01. Mr. McCollough stated to the inspector that the gauge had been used once or twice a week by Well Site.
- As of May 5, 1993, Mr. McCollough claims to have been unaware that License 35-23183-01 had been revoked on October 23, 1992.

The OI investigation produced insuficient evidence to conclude that Well Site had deliberately violated NRC requirements by possessing licensed material without an NRC license. While not deliberate, a violation of NRC requirements did occur. Although NRC normally would issue a Notice of Violation upon finding that Well Site (Mr. McCollough) possessed a pipe wall thickness gauge without a license, we are not doing so, since the gauge was transferred to a properly authorized licensee, Tubular Technology, Inc.

However, if you apply for another NRC license, either as an individual or as an owner or officer of a corporation, at that time we will ask you to provide

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written assurance that such violations will not occur under the license being applied for.
