

Gentlemen:

This refers to your three letters dated August 24, 1979, with which you provided results of Performance Classification Tests.

The information you provided specifies that Module Nos. 2020, 1920, and 2040 were tested in watchcases other than those now specifically provided for in License No. 37-02572-07E. There is no identification of the light sources in the modules. License No. 37-03572-07E specifically provides for use of American Atomic Corporation light sources. Since American Atomics Corporation has been out of operation for several months, we need to know whether the light sources in the modules in the watches tested by Self Powered Lighting were American Atomics Corporation light sources as specified in your libense. We noted that the tests were conducted in August 1979 which was after American Atomics Corporation stopped light source production.

If the light sources were other than American Atomics Corporation light sources, we need specific identification of the light sources, how they are constructed, results of tests performed on them, the quality control procedures for assuring that the light sources meet specifications, and now the manufacturer provides you with assurance that the light sources meet all specifications.



He note that nearly all the light sources designated in your license are American Atomics Corporation light sources. He ether light sources may be used under License No. 57-03572-07E is amended to provide for them and complete information is provided concerning the light sources and the prototype testing of matches containing the new light sources.
