The Exxon Nuclear Company has been notified by its customer, OKG Aktiebolog, (formerly Oskarshamnsverkets Kraftgrupp AB) Birger Jalsrgatan 41A, 1187 Stockholm, Sweden, of its need to increase the number of fuel elements from 80 to 90 for reload XN-5. Therefore, it is requested that the amount of uranium allowed to be exported under license XSNM01903 be increased from 30,900 to 33,750 kilograms and the amount of contained U-235 from 1082 to 1135 kilograms. The maximum enrichment remains unchanged at 3.5 w/o.
