XSNM 01645 amend 1 WITHTRAWAL

Subject: Withdrawal - Application Amendment

License No. XSNM 1645

Dear Ms. Wright:

On January 6, 1983, General Electric filed an application amendment to XSNM 1645 for export of 1500 kilograms of natural enrichment UO2 powder, to the ENUSA fuel fabrication facility in Spain. Of the requested 1500 kilograms, 1000 kilograms is to be used in activities related to equipment startup, the remaining portion for post start-up fuel fabrication. It has come to our attention that the ENUSA facility may not have been completely documented as to international safeguards. We understand also that it is authorized by the Government of Spain presently to use natural material only. While the facility ultimately will produce fuel for the nuclear power plant utilizing natural and LEU powder, it is not necessary at this time to cover the ENUSA fabrication plant for any activities beyond receipt of a single, 1000 kilogram natural uranium shipment.

Accordingly, General Electric hereby requests withdrawal of its January 6, 1983 Application Amendment for XSNM 1645. A separate application will be filed for the natural enrichment powder for start-up purposes.
