## Haddam Neck Plant Request for Information on MCC-5 Reliability

The purpose of this letter is to provide the NRC Staff with information to assist them in their review of a recent design change with regard to the motor control center (MCC)-5 automatic bus transfer (ABT) scheme.

In a letter dated February 25, 1994,<sup>(1)</sup> Connecticut Yankee Atomic Power Company (CYAPCO) informed the Staff that they intended to implement a modification to the ABT scheme prior to startup from the recent service water system outage. Prior to this letter, CYAPCO had provided design details regarding this modification to members of the Staff. As of this date the modification has been successfully implemented, and the Haddam Neck Plant returned to service and is currently on-line.

CYAPCO implemented the aforementioned design modification without prior NRC Staff review and approval in accordance with 10CFR50.59. However, CYAPCO has been providing the NRC Staff with information to support the Staff's own informal review of this design modification.

In a recent telephone conversation, the Staff requested that CYAPCO provide information regarding an evaluation of the impact on MCC-5 reliability by changing from the previous ABT transfer scheme to the new one installed during the recent service water system-related plant outage.
