PECO Energy Company is submitting Technical Specifications (TS) Change Request No. 93-21-0 in accordance with 10 CFR 50.90, requesting an amendment to the TS (i.e., Appendix A) of Operating License Nos. NPF-39 and NPF-85 for Limerick Generating Station, Units 1 and 2, respectively. This proposed TS Change revises TS Surveillance Requirement 4.8.1.1.2e.8, which requires that a diesel generator be retested within 5 minutes after completing a 24 hour endurance run.
