Our review of the severe accident portion of your application for a Final Design Approval of your Standard Nuclear Island has identified the need for a computer input tape for the fault/event tree preparations identified in your P.R.A. This tape should be in the following format suitable for the CDC-7600 computer: 9 track, 1600 bpi, unlabeled ASCII or EBCDIC and 10 records per block. It is preferred that the tape contain inputs for the fault/event trees corresponding to all dominant accident sequences in the GESSAR II PRA.
