FOR THE COOPER NUCLEAR STATION

Enclosed is a letter from Megs Hepler of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) dated May 2, 1994, transmitting the subject report for the Cooper Nuclear Station.

There were 4 Deficiencies identified during the December 15, 1993, exercise. All 4 Deficiencies were corrected during a remedial exercise conducted on February 9, 1994. In addition to the four Deficiencies, there were 16 Areas Requiring Corrective Action (ARCA) identified during the exercise. FEMA Region VII staff will coordinate with the States of Nebraska and Missouri to correct the ARCAs on or before the next scheduled biennial exercise.

Please forward a copy of the enclosed FEMA letter and exercise report to the licensee and request that the licensee follow up with offsite officials on the Areas Requiring Corrective Action.
