
Gentlemen:

Millstone Nuclear Power Station Unit No. 1
SEP Topic II-3.B, Flooding Potential and Protection Requirements

In Reference (1), Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) agreed to keep the large flood door (across the roll-up door entrance) to the gas turbine building normally closed. The purpose of this was to provide additional assurance that ponded water resulting from a Probable Maximum Precipitation at the Millstone site would not enter the gas turbine building through this potential pathway. OPS Form 682.1-1 (attachment to SP 682.1, Monthly Flood Gate Check) has been revised to indicate that this door should be normally closed. Position of the large flood door will be verified monthly.
