Dear Mr. Thomas:

Enclosed are six copies of our newly revised security plan, which is being submitted as part of our Facility license renewal. It was prepared in conformance with 10 CFR part 73.67(f), "Fixed site requirements for special nuclear material of low strategic significance". The format follows Regulatory Guide 5.59, and was prepared in consultation with Ms. Carol Rossomondo and Mr. Russell Rentschler of the NRC.

Please note that the provisions of 10 CFR part 73.67(b)(2) were used to obtain low strategic significance status. At present, we possess slightly more than 1 Kg. of nuclear material, and so we have established CAAs in two separate buildings. If we are successful in reducing our inventory, we may wish to eliminate the Howe CAA at a future time.

Since public disclosure of the enclosed material could jeopardize our security system, we request that it not be filed in the public reading room, as provided for in 10 CFR 2.79.
