This letter submits an update to a previous report submitted on August 13, 1982. The event for which the report was submitted occurred on July 18, 1982, when Diesel Generator 13 was shutdown prior to completion of a functional test because of a generator RTD high temperature alarm. The event was reported pursuant to Technical Specification 6.9.1.13.c.

A review of affected procedures has determined that they are adequate to prevent a similar event to occur during surveillance testing. Attached is LER 82-020/03 X-1, which is a final report.
