Technical Specification Change Request No. 214

By letter dated April 6, 1994, GPU Nuclear Corporation, licensee of the Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station (OCNGS), submitted the subject amendment to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. The proposed change would eliminate the OCNGS Technical Specification scram and isolation functions, initiated by a trip signal from the main steam line radiation monitors.
