This letter refers to a special safety inspection conducted by Sheri A. Arredondo, of this office, on April 27, 1994, at the above address and at 320 Putnam Avenue, Cambridge, Massachusetts of activities authorized by the above listed NRC license and subsequent telephone conversation on May 3, 1994, between Dr. Brent Dorval and Ms. Arredondo. The inspection was limited to a review of the storage of radioactive materials at your facilities and their decommissioning.

Your company was notified in a letter dated February 7, 1994 to William Terry Elliott that your application for a new license was deficient and that additional information was required. In a telephone conversation on March 31, 1994 between Dr. Dorval and Steven Shaffer, of this office, we were notified that you no longer desire to request an NRC license. Consequently, Mr. Shaffer requested that you submit the results of your closeout survey. As of May 3, 1994 the NRC had not received the required results of your closeout survey.

From discussions with you during the inspection, and subsequent phone call, we understand that you will complete 1) the final disposition of all radioactive waste, and 2) a comprehensive survey for radiation, radioactive materials, and radioactive contamination that may exist at your facilities located at 359 Allston Street and 320 Putnam Avenue, Cambridge, Massachusetts. We further understand that you will submit the above corresponding paperwork to our office.

Failure to complete the actions addressed in this letter by June 15, 1994 may lead to enforcement actions.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were identified.
