Enclosed is Materials License No. SNM-1174, as renewed. The license contains specific conditions which we have discussed with you.

The license is hereby renewed for a five-year term expiring March 31, 1988.

You are hereby advised that any requests for amendments to the license should continue to be submitted in the form of replacement or new pages for the sections of your application incorporated as license conditions (Appendix A dated October 15, 1982; Termination Plans Part IV, V, and VI dated January 8, 1980 and submitted in your renewal application of March 29, 1982; and the Environmental Monitoring Procedure: KM-NC-20-2, Revision 3 submitted in the March 29, 1982 license renewal request)) to this license and, where applicable, for the Demonstration Section with the changes or new items clearly identified.

Please note we are including in your license a revision of your March 29, 1982 submittal: Annex C, "Guidelines for Decontamination of Facilities and Equipment Prior to Release for Unrestricted Use or Termination of Licenses for Byproduct, Source, or Special Nuclear Materials." This revision is referenced in License Condition No. 16 of your renewed license.

Also in this renewal action we are including a License Condition 19 pertaining to the use of respiratory protection against radiation. Accordingly, Kerr-McGee's Annex A, "Respiratory Requirements," submitted March 29, 1982 may require modification to meet the current 10 CFR 20 regulation, a copy of which is attached for your convenience.

The Materials and Plant Protection Amendment issued pursuant to Parts 70 and 73 a d the Certificates of Compliance issued pursuant to 10 CFR Part 71 are not affected by this licensing action and remain in effect.

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Based on our review of your application, we have concluded that the activities authorized by this license can be performed without undue risk to the health and safety of the public and that the application fulfills the requirements of Section 70.23(a), 10 CFR 70.
