


On November 6, 1981 at approximately 0945 AM, 17 mCi of 99m Technetium pertechnetate was inadvertently administered to a patient scheduled for a MDP bone scan. Results of nonlocalization in skeletal tissue caused the facts to appear. [] the referring physician, was notified. There was no adverse affect on the patient. The case was reviewed by physicians and technical staff and measures were proposed to avoid repetition.
