March 15, 1983 (9:00 AM - 4:00 PM)

A site tour will be made with the applicant and their consultants. The review group has expressed specific areas to be highlighted during the tour as follows:

1. Stratigraphy - Examine exposures of soil and rock that are representative of those materials beneath and around the site.
2. Structure - Examine exposures of faults in the site area, and the evidence used to support the conclusion that these faults are not a hazard to the site (capable fault).
3. Landslides - Examine representative landslides in the area and review bases for conclusions made regarding their significance to the site.

All persons to go on the tour are to meet inside the Site Construction Office Building at 9:00 AM. The specific route will be announced at that time. This meeting is expected to take no more than 20 minutes in order to allow the tour to begin in a timely manner.

March 16, 1983 (1:00 PM - 4:00 PM)

A discussion will be held between the NRC staff and the applicant. The discussion will encompass the technical discussion items listed below and other areas of interest developed during the site tour.

1. Earthquake potential of the Juan de Fuca subduction zone.
2. The controlling earthquake for seismic design, ground motion and margins.
