In response to your request of January 27, 1983 to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission for resource information pertaining to the South Atlantic Outer Continental Shelf (OCS) Lease Sale No. 90 (Ref. 3312.90), we are pleased to provide the following information.

There are two nuclear power plants located on the Atlantic Coast within the Sale No. 90 planning area -- the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant in North Carolina and the St. Lucie Plant in Florida. The Brunswick Plant is located at the mouth of the Cape Fear River, about 16 miles south of Wilmington, North Carolina. Its coordinates are latitude 33° 57' 30" and longitude 78° 0' 38". The St. Lucie Plant is located on Hutchinson Island about midway between the cities of Fort Pierce and Stuart, Florida. Its coordinates are latitude 27° 20' 55" and longitude 30° 14' 47".

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is interested in activities which may involve or result in the transportation or location of toxic, flammable, or explosive materials within about 3 miles of a nuclear power plant. In the event that your lease sale would potentially result in such activities in the vicinity of one of the above plants, the NRC should be notified so that a safety evaluation may be conducted. The NRC contact for such a review is the Site Analysis Branch, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation.
