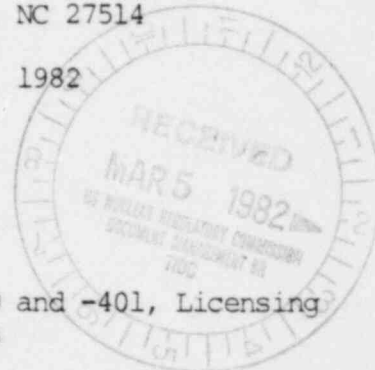

CHANGE filed for leave to intervene by letter posted from Washington, DC on February 19, 1982. This letter is to amplify and amend that petition.

1. 

Request documents: In order to fully prepare our contentions and other documents, CHANGE hereby requests that a copy of the Final Safety Analysis Report and the Draft Environmental Report be forwarded to CHANGE, P.O. Box 524, Chapel Hill, NC 27514, as soon as possible. These documents are not otherwise available except at distances of 18 miles or more, which is unduly burdensome on CHANGE in light of the limited time available and the amount of study and work involved.
