This is to inform you, in accordance with the requirements of the Nuclear Non-Proliferation Act, that the NRC has not completed licensing action on your license application XSNM02785 for the export of low enriched uranium to the Czech Republic for the initial core and four reload regions each for Temelin Nuclear Power Station Units 1 and 2.

Favorable Executive Branch views on this application were received by the NRC on March 23, 1994. The Commission is addressing the Petition for Intervention and Request for Hearing of the Natural Resources Defense Council, Friends of the Earth, Hnuti Duha, and Global 2000, dated March 17, 1994, and undated petitions from Greenpeace Austria, and Oberosterreichische Plattform gegen Atomgerahr. A Commission decision on these matters will be issued in the near future.
