This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Messrs. J. R. Waters, F. R. Dunaway and P. L. Hartmann of this office on December 2, 1982 through January 17, 1983, of activities at Zion Nuclear Power Station, Units 1 and 2, authorized by NRC Operating Licenses No. DPR-39 and No. DPR-48 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. K. L. Graesser at the conclusion of the inspection.


