Dear Ms. Dolce:

We currently hold Material License No. 20-13204-01 which covers our very small scale and infrequent use of radioisotopes. The purpose of this letter is to indicate my understanding of our present license status.

In my letter of August 5, 1993, I indicated that we were unable to pay the exorbitant annual license and inspection fee which was assessed, and therefore requested that our license be terminated.

In a September 9, 1993 telephone conversation, you acquainted me with the possibility that there may be waiver of our license fee. In a further conversation on November 16, 1993, you indicated that a decision in the matter was still pending.

If, indeed, a waiver of our fees does occur, I wish to immediately cancel the request for license termination. At present, while a decision on fees is pending, I understand that our request for termination is being held in abeyance.

Thus, our request for license termination is contingent upon imposition of the unaffordable fees which will force us to cease our operations; in the absence of these fees, we would very much like to retain our license and continue our operation.
