The University of Delaware requests the following amendments to its Byproduct Material License Number 07-01579-19 (Docket Number 030-10925). These amendments are submitted prior to August 19, 1993 in order to avoid the 1993 annual fee for fee categories 5.A. and 1.D. as discussed in the August 6, 1993 notice from Mr. James M. Taylor, USNRC Executive Director for Operations.

Possession Only Status for Byproduct Source I.

This 125 mCi Cs-137 source, which had been used for well logging purposes, will no longer be used. It will be kept in storage only until transfer to another licensee or disposal can be arranged. The source is a 3M Model 4F6B, serial number 1022, incorporated into a Neltronic Instrument Corporation Model DM source holder.

Robin Elliott, the Radiation Safety Officer, will exercise control of the source by securing the source in a storage location under her direct control. Leak tests of the source will be performed at least once every three years and immediately before transfer to an authorized recipient. The source will be physically inventoried annually. Except for revocation of the internal authorization to use the source, there are no planned changes to the University radiation safety program as a result of the placement of this source in storage.

Efforts have been made to transfer the source to other authorized recipients. Telephone calls were made on August 9, 1993 to the fabricator and supplier of the source-- Neltronic Instrument Company, Nuclear Sources & Services, Inc., and Gammatron, Inc. Efforts were also made to transfer the source to a local well logging company. No contacted party was interested in accepting the source. Inquiries are now being made through a waste broker, RSO Inc., to determine whether the source can be accepted as waste for burial at the LLRW site in Barnwell, South Carolina.

Possession Only Status for SNM Sources L. and M.


These Pu-239 sources are encapsulated as Pu-Be neutron sources, and had been used for meter calibration and neutron activation analysis. They will no longer be used and will be kept in storage only until transfer to another licensee or disposal can be arranged. Source L. is a 80 gram NUMEC Model Type 1; source M. is a 16 gram Monsanto Model 1 Curie PuBe.

Robin Elliott, the Radiation Safety Officer, will exercise control of the sources by securing them in restricted storage locations already approved by the University License. She will maintain the only keys which unlock the source shields and allow direct access to the sources. Leak tests of the sources will be performed at least once every three years and immediately before transfer to an authorized recipient. The sources will be physically inventoried annually. The internal authorization to use the two sources will be revoked. Instruments requiring neutron calibration will now be sent to a calibration facility instead of being calibrated in-house. This is the only planned change to the University radiation safety program as a result of the placement of these sources in storage.

Disposal options for these sources are very limited. The existing LLRW site at Barnwell, South Carolina will not accept these sources as waste. The DOE through Los Alamos National Lab has established a program to accept such sources, however, per phone conversation with Ms. Sherry Jones on September 8, 1992, no more sources can be accepted until at least 1995. Further, periodic attempts will be made to dispose of the two Pu-239 sources through this program.

Thank you for your consideration of this license amendment request. Please note that the University is also considering the filing of an exemption request for all annual fees after reviewing the forthcoming "considerations to be addressed" discussed in Mr. Taylor's notice of August 6, 1993.
