Dear Mr. Griffin:

We wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated December 3, 1982, concerning your inquiry in obtaining a written confirmation from this Embassy.

Please be informed that we just received information from Indonesia and on behalf of the National Atomic Energy Agency of Indonesia (Badan Tenaga Atom Nasional), we would like to confirm:

1. That 16.2 kg uranium in TRIGA fuel elements will be distributed for the two facilities, namely:
 - a. Bandung reactor: 14.8 kg uranium containing 2.9 kg U-235.
 - b. Kartini Reactor, Yogyakarta: 1.4 kg uranium containing .3 kg U-235.

a identified on the license of General Atomic Technologies, Inc., as of November 8, 1982 to be transferred to Indonesia, will be subject to all of the terms and conditions of the Agreement for Cooperation, which entered into force on December 30, 1981, concerning the civil uses of atomic energy between the Government of the Republic of Indonesia and the Government of the United States of America.
2. The ultimate consignee, as identified on the application, is authorized by our Government to receive and possess the materials.

We would appreciate it very much if you could notify the General Atomic Technologies, Inc., San Diego, California to implement the shipment at their earliest convenience.
