## Gentlemen:

By letter dated December 14, 1982, the Division of Licensing (DL) staff acted upon your request dated March 19, 1981, as supplemented and amended by letters dated May 5, August 21, 1981, March 29, July 13 and September 21, 1982. The request was for exemption from certain requirements of 10 CFR 50.48 and Appendix R to 10 CFR 50 for the Trojan Nuclear Plant. Fees pursuant to 10 CFR 170.22 were not remitted with your request.

Based on infomation provided by the DL staff as the result of their final review of your request, it has been determined that a Class III fee $(\$ 4,000)$ is appropriste for those portions of your request pertaining to Appendix R, Section III.G.2, for the Fuel Building and the Auxiliary Building. Therefore, it is requested that your Company remit a sum of $\$ 4,000$ to this office.

It is currently NRC policy to exempt from fees those requests that are approved pursuant to 10 CFR 50.12 in cases where no license amendment is issued. Since the remaining portions of your March 19, 1981 request, as revised, were granted pursuant to 10 CFR 50.12, we have concluded that an exemption (pursuant to 10 CFR 170.11(b)) from the $\mathrm{fe}_{\mathrm{E}}$ requirements of Part 170 is authorized by law and such exemption is otherwise in the public interest and is hereby granted for the remaining portion of March 19, 1981 request, as revised.
