Dear Sir/Madam:

This is a Freedom of Information Act request, pursuant to 5 USC 552, et seq., for production and disclosure of information discussed below.

The information requested relates to the transportation of radioactive spent fuel and/or wastes by Virginia Electric Power Company. Specifically I request:

A. The application that VEPCO submitted to NRC, which I am told is dated July 13, 1982, for approval of routes for spent fuel shipment. Naturally I am aware that some of this material may be exempt because of its character as genuinely proprietary or safeguards-related information. I presume that material will not be withheld from this application on the pretext that it is "pre-decisional", as if it were NRC-generated information.

B. Other applications that VEPCO may have submitted which are related to the proposed transportation: e.g., license modification applications.

C. Correspondence, memos, notes of meetings, etc. related to these applications.

D. Documents related to noncompliance by VEPCO of nuclear transport regulations.

The Environmental Policy Institute is a non-profit, public interest group to promote safe use of the environment. Accordingly, pursuant to 5 USC 552 (a)(4), I request a waiver of any fees associated with the processing of this request, as the information sought is solely to be used for the benefit of the general public.

If I do not receive a response within ten working days as required by the FOIA, I will deem my request denied. If you determine that some portions of the requested information are exempt from release, I request that you provide me with a copy of the remainder of the file in addition to a list of the material not provided, with the date, author, addressee, and title of each document withheld.
