In your letter dated May 5, 1994 you requested an additional 30 days to respond to Violation 4A to License No. 24-00167-11 which involved the failure to discontinue patient treatment when patient viewing via video camera was not available. Please be advised that we are granting this extension for you to respond to this violation for the reasons stated in your letter.

We have reviewed your corrective actions, which appear to be adequate, and have no further questions at this time. These corrective actions will be examined during a future inspection.
