SUBJECT: NOTICE OF VIOLATION (NRC INSPECTION REPORT NO. 30-14891/94-01)

This refers to the inspection conducted by Kent M. Prendergast of this office on April 18 and 19, 1994. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Wahiawa, Hawaii, facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with you and members of your staff. Additionally, subsequent information was also provided by Mrs. Marta Davidson, R.N. on April 29 and May 2, 1994.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under the license as they related to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress. The purpose of the inspection was to determine whether activities authorized by the license were conducted safely and in accordance with NRC requirements.

Based on the results of this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Nutice of Violation (Notice). The violations are of concern because they demonstrate a lack of awareness of regulatory requirements and a need for increased management oversight of licensed activities.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. In your response, you should document the specific actions taken and any additional actions you plan to prevent recurrence. After reviewing your response to this Notice, including your proposed corrective actions and the results of future inspections, the NRC will determine whether further NRC enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with NRC regulatory requirements.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

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The responses directed by this letter and the enclosed Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, Pub. L. No. 96.511.
