Thank you for your response of April 22, 1994, received on April 28, 1994, to our Notice of Violation, issued on March 28, 1994, concerning activities conducted under NRC License No. 47-25233-01MD. We have evaluated your response and found that it meets the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201. Concerning your Ludlum Model 2200 counting equipment, we agree that as long as you follow the guidance in NRC Information Notice 93-30, including documentation of your efforts, you should be able to demonstrate that your equipment is sensitive enough to meet NRC regulatory requirements. Our records have been modified to reflect that the Ludlum Model 2200 counting equipment example is not included in the violation. We will examine the implementation of your corrective actions during future inspections.
