Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552, et seq., I am requesting, on behalf of Lieutenant Governor Madeleine Kunin, that you furnish copies of the following described agency records:


- (1) Any correspondence between your agency and Governor Richard A. Snelling of Vermont, or members of his staff (including, but not limited to Dean Pineles, Thomas Evslin, or William Gilbert), and dated between August 25, 1982 and the present, which relates to the transport of nuclear waste material through the state of Vermont and/or public release of the dates of any such transport;
- (2) Any writings memorializing conversations between officials of your agency and Governor Richard A. Snelling of Vermont or members of his staff (including, but not limited to Dean Pineles, Thomas Evslin or William Gilbert), and dated between August 25, 1982 and the present, which related to the transport of nuclear waste material through the state of Vermont and/or public release of the dates of any such transport;
- (3) Any correspondence or other writing between the agency and Nuclear Assurance Corporation of Atlanta, Georgia, dated after November 13, 1981, which relates to a revision in the anticipated schedule or number of shipments of irradiated fuel from the Chalk River Nuclear Laboratories, originally scheduled to commence on May 18, 1982, and to consist of six shipments.
