SUBJECT: CHANGES TO THE SOUTH TEXAS PROJECT ELECTRIC GENERATING STATION

EMERGENCY PLAN, REVISION 16

We have received your letter dated February 9, 1994, which transmitted Revision 16 to the South Texas Project Electric Generating Station Emergency Plan. Revision 16 was submitted pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(q) and incorporated the following changes: (1) emergency action level changes (received prior approval), (2) EPA-400 changes, (3) offsite agency title changes, (4) emergency response organization title changes, (5) staff augmentation time changes (received prior approval), (6) emergency response facilities and equipment description changes, (7) 10 CFR Part 20 changes, and (8) editorial changes.

We have reviewed Revision 16 and have determined that the revision is acceptable and does not appear to degrade the effectiveness of your emergency planning at South Texas Project Electric Generating Station.

During our review we identified several sections of the emergency plan that had not been fully revised to incorporate 10 CFR 20 and EPA-400 changes. These sections were discussed with Mr. P. Serra and Ms. K. Doss on May 23, 1994. Based on that discussion, your staff agreed to issue Interim Change Notice 16-1 to address the following issues: (1) Sections E.2.2-4 would be modified to reference the revised Part 20, (2) Table I-1 would be revised to fully capture EPA-400 changes, and (3) the definition of "CDE" in Attachment 5 would be modified to include reference to a specific organ.
