

NOTICE OF APPEAL FROM MEMORANDUM AND ORDER OF  
ATOMIC SAFETY AND LICENSING BOARD, DATED FEBRUARY 22, 1983

Comes now the Coalition for Safe Power ("Petitioner") and pursuant to 10 CFR 2.714a(a)&(b) does appeal to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission from the "Memorandum and Order (Dismissing Petition and Denying Hearing)" of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board in the above-captioned matter dated February 22, 1983 and served February 23, 1983 as follows:

1. The Licensing Board found that Petitioner failed to meet the Commission's second test derived from CLI-89-29, 16 NRC \_\_\_\_\_, October 8, 1982, in that it did not particularize and support an allegation that the Permittee had intended to cause delays or had taken actions resulting in delays because it was indifferent to delay.
