- 1) Phoenix Surveys admits to the alleged violations in the above referenced docket.
- The reason for the violation was unfamiliarity with the regulations because we had not previously worked outside the State of Colorado.
- 3) The corrective actions taken include the filing of Form-241 for both 1993 and 1994 and the subsequent amendments of Form-241 for 1994 to date.
- 4) The corrective steps taken to avoid further violations include: amendment of our Colorado license to name a new Radiation Safety Officer to improve our ability to comply with state and NRC regulations. Additionally we have developed procedures to check the status of reciprocity and the reporting requirements for NRC and agreement states outside of Colorado when operations involving radioactive sources are involved.
- Full compliance was achieved within days of the second Wyoming operation and we have been in full compliance throughout 1994.
