The referenced letter transmitted License Amendment Request 94-002 which revised the Quadrant Power Tilt Ratio Technical Specification. As part of that Technical Specification change request, Surveillance Requirements 4.2.4.1 and 4.2.4.2 were combined into Surveillance Requirement 4.2.4.1. Surveillance Requirement 4.2.4.2 was deleted. Subsequently, a reference to Surveillance Requirement 4.2.4.2 was discovered in Technical Specification Table 3.3-1, ACTION STATEMENTS, ACTION 2-c. Attachment 2 provides a marked-up page of Technical Specification Table 3.3-1 which revises that reference to be Surveillance Requirement 4.2.4.1.
