The purpose of this letter is to identify the startup testing schedule for McGuire Unit 2 so that NRC licensing activities can be scheduled accordingly.

Initial criticality is currently scheduled for April 25, 1983, and testing at less than 5% power level is expected to be completed by May 16, 1983. Since the McGuire Unit 2 license presently limits reactor power level to less than 5%, we would appreciate NRC efforts to issue a full-power operating license by May 16, 1983. We will continue to work with the NRC staff to resolve any questions or concerns related to approval of the full-power operating license.
